



## Hospital Multidisciplinary Award 2017

Treatment of patients is, in most cases, a combined effort of several individuals and it is recognised that the outcome of a procedure is optimal when the professionals do indeed work together as a team.

This Award will seek to recognise those who can demonstrate added value by their contribution. The judging panel will want to see actual multidisciplinary healthcare working and actual examples of it in practice as well as an outline of what lessons have been learnt from its implementation.

### WHO CAN ENTER?

This category is open to all hospital professionals working within the hospital sector in Ireland. Applications can be through nominating an individual or yourself. Previous Hospital Professional Awards Hospital Multidisciplinary Award entrants, including winners, are also welcome to submit entries this year.

All entries will be judged by an independent panel of experts and the winners will be announced at the Hospital Pharmacy Awards 2017 on Saturday, September 16th in the Clayton Hotel, Dublin.


